Now in its second year, the WEF Volunteer Service Recognition Program will honor members who significantly contribute to the successes and achievements of the organization by serving on a WEF committee or in the WEF House of Delegates. This year, as many as 15 members will be recognized through the program and will receive a service recognition pin during WEFTEC 2018.

WEF's Committee Leadership Council and House of Delegates started the program to recognize outstanding volunteers.

All WEF committees and the WEF House of Delegates will accept nominations through June 30. To be eligible for the recognition, nominees must be a member of WEF for a minimum of 5 years; serve in a leadership or substantial service role as an active member of a committee, task force, or workgroup; and contribute unique, innovative, or creative perspectives to a committee, task force, or workgroup.
