- Joint Annual Meeting
 - First joint annual meeting with Missouri AWWA held in 2003. Currently in the fourth year of a six year commitment, with support from both organizations to continue. March 2009 meeting had 521 attendees, 98 exhibitors, and 6 concurrent sessions.
- Outreach Programs
 - Several MWEA committees including the Laboratory, Collections, Biosolids, Plant Managers, Equipment Operations & Maintenance, and Small Flows host 1-day workshops throughout the state. The Fall Workshop includes a Collections track and a Treatment Facilities track. The Young Professionals Committee holds monthly activities in the St. Louis and Kansas City regions.
- Stockholm Junior Water Prize
 - MWEA will be hosting the Stockholm Junior Water Prize competition in St. Louis in 2010. An ad-hoc committee has been set up to coordinate arrangements for this event.
