

## **Water Environment Federation Honorary Membership Policy**

It is the policy of the Water Environment Federation that persons nominated for Honorary Membership be persons of acknowledged eminence, making extraordinary contributions to WEF, or making extraordinary contributions to policy, legislative and regulatory development in one or more fields of activity within the scope of the stated WEF objectives.

### **Criteria**

- WEF Honorary Membership shall not exceed a ratio of one Honorary Member to every 350 Individual members.
- A maximum of three Honorary Members shall be elected in any calendar year.
- Nomination for Honorary Membership may be made by any Member Association, member, or by the Nominating Committee.
- Election to Honorary Membership shall be only by secret ballot vote of a minimum of two-thirds of the House, resulting in an affirmative vote by 90 percent of votes cast.

### **Privileges**

- Rights and privileges of an Individual Member.
- Elected for life,
- Awarded a certificate by the WEF,
- Pays no Federation dues
- Complimentary subscription to Water Environment & Technology

WEF Honorary Members are not, by virtue of such membership, relieved of paying dues to Member Associations to which they may belong unless such dues are waived by the Member Association.
