Event Attendee Terms and Conditions

By registering for and participating in any Event hosted by the Water Environment Federation[®] ("WEF[®]") and the Water Reuse Association ("WRA[®]"), including its 2025 WEF/WRA Industrial Water Solutions Conference ("Event"), you, on your behalf and on behalf of any other third party acting on your behalf (collectively "you" or "Attendee") hereby agree to these Terms and Conditions.

- 1. 3. NO RECORDING. Among any other remedies

available to it, WEF and WRA expressly reserves its right to terminate Attendee's participation in the Event immediately upon notification that any Public Statements have been distributed in violation of this provision and obtain an injunction to enjoin any further dissemination of Public Statements in violation of this provision, in addition to any other remedies available to WEF and WRA.

4. PARTICIPATION. You agree to contribute Personal Data for the purpose of participating in the Event. You represent and warrant that the Personal Data you provide shall be accurate and complete. You agree to provide truthful and accurate registration information as requested; and to promptly inform WEF of any changes to your registration information. Such Personal Data will only be used by WEF or WRA and its contractors as reasonably required for providing services as contemplated hereunder.

5. CANCELLATION AND SUBSTITUTION.

Cancellations/Refunds: All cancellations must be received in writing and sent to WEF at *registration@wef.org*. WEF will charge a 25% cancellation fee for cancellation requests received by June 6, 2025. **NO** refunds will be issued for cancellations requested on or **after June 7**, **2025.** Rather than canceling, consider sending a substitute.

Substitutions: An organization may submit a request to substitute one person for another in writing on or before June 6, 2025. Please submit your substitution request to registration@wef.org. On or after June 7, 2025, substitutions must be done onsite at the Hyatt Regency Columbus, in Columbus, Ohio; beginning Monday, June 23, through Wednesday, June 25, 2025.

- 6. VIEWS. The views expressed by any Event attendee, speaker or sponsor are not necessarily those of WEF and WRA.
