Term:

The term of the Member Involvement Director is three years with a maximum of two consecutive terms.

Reporting Structure:

The Water for People Committee, Young Professionals Committee, and Operator Involvement Committee all report to the Member Involvement Director.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Ensures that the Water for People Committee, Young Professionals Committee, and Operator Involvement Committee have a Chair.
- Provides the support required in order for the Committees to execute their functions effectively.
- Maintains contact with Water for People, Young Professionals, and Operator Involvement Chairs.
- Provides liaison between the Committee Chairs and the ACWWA Board and provides the Board with updates on Committee activities, needs, and initiatives.
- Advises Committee Chairs of relevant Board decisions that may impact their committee.
- Participates in all aspects of the Board's function, and represents the Board at Committee events where possible.
- Assist the Atlantic Canada Water and Wastewater Association in creating an inclusive, diverse and equitable membership and in establishing an organizational
