

INDUSTRIAL WATER QUALITY FOCUSED

Industrial Water Quality Achievement Award

The Industrial Water Quality Achievement Award is presented to an industry and, if applicable, to its engineering firm that best demonstrates significant, lasting, and measurable excellence in water quality improvement or in the prevention of water quality degradation as demonstrated by innovative design and operation of an industrial wastewater, pretreatment or source prevention program.

Criteria:

- i. The program should be implemented by an industry or show significant input by industry.
- ii. Joint awards between industrial and engineering consultants will be made for innovative designs or process alternations or management.
- iii. The program must lie within the boundaries of one or more Member Association(s) sponsoring the nomination.
- iv. A program is eligible during a five-year period immediately following the results are published, or become a matter of public record. Two renominations may be made.
- v. The program must demonstrate a significant achievement in design, operation, or process change resulting in long-term water quality improvement. The application should give specific detail as to the nature of the engineering or scientific advances leading to the improvement.

W. Wesley Eckenfelder Industrial Water Quality Achievement Award

The W. Wesley Eckenfelder Industrial Water Quality Lifetime Achievement Award recognizes and honors an individual who has made substantial engineering, scientific, and/or operations contributions to the management or treatment of industrial wastes related to the improvement of water quality.

Criteria:

i. Member of the Water Environment Federation ii. A minimum of 25 years of significant technical contributions and impact on the body of engineering, scientific, and operational knowledge related to the treatment and/or disposal of industrial wastes. iii. Significant contribution to the professional advancement of engineers, scientists and/or

other professionals in the area of industrial waste management.
