



By registering for and participating in any event hosted by Water Environment Federation® ("WEF®") and American Water Works Association ("AWWA") including its 2026 Utility Management Conference™ and/or the Young Professionals Summit ("Event"), you, on your behalf and on behalf of any other third party acting on your behalf (collectively "you" or "Attendee") hereby agree to these Terms and Conditions, with WEF and/or AWWA as follows:

- 1. HEALTH & WELL-BEING PROTOCOLS:** While there are currently no protocols in place, in the event protocols are needed, all AWWA/WEF The Utility Management Conference™ and/or the Young Professionals Summit attendees agree to follow all Health & Well-being protocols implemented on-site for the event. We will continue to closely monitor all conditions related to COVID-19 between now and the start of the event and reserve the right to modify health screening protocols in our sole discretion. WEF and/or AWWA will inform you of any such changes, and as a condition of participation, you agree you will follow these protocols. Should you fail to observe any of the protocols, WEF or AWWA may remove you from the Event without refund.
- 2. CONSENT TO RECORD.** By participating in the Event, Attendee agrees that its name, photograph, voice, biographical information, likeness, name, comments, voice, persona, writings and/or personal property recordings, children (if applicable), testimonial, endorsement and any intellectual property rights on all elements contained in or resulting from participation in the Event (collectively the "Likeness") shall be captured, displayed, and may be used in any and all media or forms by WEF and/or AWWA or third parties without compensation or notice, including for promotional or advertising purposes.

Attendee understands and agrees this permission signifies that photographic or video recordings and Attendee may be electronically displayed, reproduced, recreated, recorded, performed, exhibited, distributed, copied, edited, changed, modified, added to, subtracted from, re-titled and adapted, and otherwise used and exploited

without having to give any compensation or attribution to Attendee or any third party via the Internet, email or in other public educational settings without notice.

3. **NO RECORDING.** Attendee further agrees Attendee shall not use any audio or video recording technology (including devices with digital camera functionality, such as smartphones or tablets, and recording software, such as screen capture or similar software) during a presentation and not record or photograph any speakers or any presentation at the Event, unless expressly permitted by WEF and/or AWWA. Attendee shall not make any part of the materials presented at the Event (any "Materials") public or issue any press releases related to the Event without express prior written approval from WEF and/or AWWA ("Public Statements"). Among any other remedies available to it, WEF and/or AWWA expressly reserves its right to terminate Attendee's participation in the Event immediately upon notification that any Public Statements have been distributed in violation of this provision and obtain an injunction to enjoin any further dissemination of Public Statements in violation of this provision, in addition to any other remedies available to WEF and/or AWWA.
4. **SUITCASING.** Suitcasing, the act of soliciting business in public spaces, including hotels or other booth or kiosk spaces, by any person or company that is not exhibiting at AWWA/WEF The Utility Management Conference™ and/or the Young Professionals Summit, is prohibited. Any violation of this requirement will result in the termination of the existing contract or registration without a refund.
5. **PARTICIPATION.** You agree to contribute Personal Data for the purpose of participating in the Event. You represent and warrant that the Personal Data you provide to the WEF and/or AWWA shall be accurate and complete. You agree to provide truthful and accurate registration information as requested by WEF and/or AWWA; and to promptly inform WEF and/or AWWA of any changes to your registration information. Such Personal Data will only be used by WEF and/or AWWA as reasonably required for providing services as contemplated hereunder. You understand that your user activity and overall presence at the conference will be monitored by our Registration Vendor, Maritz.
6. **CANCELLATION AND SUBSTITUTION. Cancellations/Refunds:** All cancellations must be received in writing and sent to Maritz. WEF will charge a 25% cancellation fee for cancellation requests received by Friday, March 13, 2026. **NO** refunds will be issued for cancellations requested **after Friday, March 13, 2026**. Rather than cancelling, attendees are encouraged to consider sending a substitute.

Substitutions: An organization may submit a request to substitute one person for another in writing prior to Friday, March 13, 2026. Submit your substitution request to Maritz. After March 13, 2026, substitutions must be done onsite at The Charlotte Convention Center beginning March 23 – 27, 2026.

Note: If you paid a member rate, but your substitution is a non-member, the substitute will need to pay the difference in cost; however, if the substitute rate is lower than the originally paid, you will not receive a difference in the price
7. **VIEWS.** The views expressed by any event attendee, speaker, exhibitor, or sponsor are not necessarily those of WEF and/or AWWA. 8. TECHNOLOGY USE. You acknowledge that your use of technology during the Event is not guaranteed. WEF and/or AWWA and its vendors will use their best efforts to communicate with attendees regarding camera use in devices and computers, mobile app capabilities in iOS and Android, audio settings and headset use, and stylus use in the Event platform.

In no event shall WEF and/or AWWA be held liable for interruptions to Internet access, power access, video camera access, or audio capabilities, nor of any similar interruptions to the virtual event platform for the duration of the posted Event website.
